



PARADUX

The fast, addictive game of opposing forces

Includes: 1 wooden playing board, 20 wooden balls

2 players, age 6+

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Objective

To be the first player to line up 4 balls of your chosen color.

Game Preparation

Place 18 balls around the perimeter of the playing board, alternating colors. Position the remaining balls as shown (diagram 1).

Game Play

Each player chooses a color. The first player selects one of their own balls and an adjoining ball of their opponents. A player may not move a ball individually or with another ball of their own color. The two balls are moved together as a single unit, one space horizontally, vertically or diagonally, in which both marbles can move freely (diagram 2).

An alternate move is to switch the places of the two adjoining marbles. (see bottom of diagram A player may not make a move which reverses the last move made.

Winning

The first player to line up four balls in a row, wins.

Don't let the simple rules of Paradux fool you into thinking it's a simple game. The strategy of the game will go as far as your wits can take it
